The Chairman signed the previous years' minutes as a true record.

The Clerk presented his report on the years' activities. (see copy opposite).

The precept remained the same for the third successive year, at £27,928.

The public were invited to raise any matters relating to the parish.

1. Mr Richards was concerned at the number of traveller type people living in caravans on land at Trehaddle. It was explained that planning permission had just been refused for the landowner and that an enforcement notice would shortly be served. It was still not certain that this would remove them as the courts would want an alternative site for them to go to, but that was a battle for the future.
2. Mrs Wharton and Ms Ward asked for, and were given an update on the current Wheal Maid position from the Parish Council viewpoint.
3. Mr Whitney asked for the road junction at Point Mills towards Twelveheads to be drawn to the Surveyors attention. There had been two incidents there recently, and the answer could be as simple as re-positioning signs to make motorists aware on the layout.
4. It was noted that today, a 30mph flashing sign had been erected opposite Cusgarne School.
