PRESENTATION

1/1088

Tracey Williams of CRCC gave a presentation on Parish Transport Grants under the Vital Villages Initiative. Grants to a maximum of £10000 (including cost of preparation of Parish Plan) were available to cover 75% of the cost of satisfying transport needs the balance coming from the Parish. Any village wanting to avail themselves of this had to undertake a Parish Plan to establish the need, state what was required to satisfy that need (bus service, shopping service, carshare facility etc.) and quantify the cost. It was recommended that any Council seeing say a requirement for a bus service which might also serve other Parishes should liaise with other Parishes to make a joint application as each was entitled to up to £10k. Drivers did not have to have PSV licence but must have 'clean' record and must be volunteers. No scheme involving paid drivers would be supported and paid drivers would need PSV licence anyway.
