PARISHIONERS' DISCUSSION

Paul Millett reported that Mrs Bunter had passed away and that the notices at the ends of the Chycoose/Hicks Mill footpath preventing horses had both been removed. Also the "Slow" sign in the road at Cusgarne and the obstructed "school" sign had not been attended to.

PC Bob Mears reported thefts of a motor vehicle at United Downs, 10 badger traps and a granite mushroom, arson of the telephone kiosk at Crofthandy, a broken window at United Downs Industrial Estate, criminal damage to Gwennap Churchyard and the theft of a tractor at Pengreep.

The Clerk confirmed that he had a number of applicants for the vacant Councillor posts and that CDC had now confirmed that both posts were now regarded as 'casual' and could be filled by co-option. It was agreed that interviews should be carried out in the week commencing 18th August and the Clerk was to arrange

2. There appeared to be a marked lack of support for the Mining Villages from CCC and CDC.
3. Reverend Hogan had produced a draft brochure on Historic Churchyards for consideration.
4. Costings for the Mineral Tramways Project were unclear

After much discussion it was agreed that the Parish was very much the poor relation of the MVRG (a position exacerbated by the apparent lack of contribution from Carrick. It was agreed that Cllr Whiteley check with Roger Radcliffe of CDC on the contribution situation and that the Clerk arrange a meeting between Bryony Veale of Kerrier DC Roger Radcliffe of CDC and members of the Council to air the thought that there is a reasoned argument for the Parish leaving MVRG and returning to Carrick. The result will be discussed at a future full meeting of the Council.
