Parishioners Discussion

Mrs Hill said she had seen the Notice and had come to record the feeling of herself and others that the Parish Rates were very high, that the fight had been fought and lost and that no more money was wasted. It was explained to her that the rates were high as it was a very large parish with a small population and that the amount of precept spent was perhaps only £2/3 per household. The situation re the IPPC Permit application was explained to her along with the history of the campaign and she accepted that there was substantially more than she had realised. The Chairman outlined the situation and Cllr Massie then gave a detailed talk on the application and the responses so far seen which indicated that there were serious engineering flaws in the application. Recognising that the health professionals had already submitted a highly detailed case against proposed by the Chairman (seconded by Cllr Millett) (Cllr Ivey abstained) **IT WAS RESOLVED** that the Council should allocate £2500 of its funds towards the obtaining of independent professional advice and the preparation of a response on the engineering aspects.

At the request of the Chairman it is minuted that Mrs Hill had said she had not gone to the Environment Agency public consultation having been told on the 'phone she could only go by appointment and that she was expecting a proper presentation
