FOOTPATHS etc TENDER 02/172

The Clerk reported that following an Invitation to Treat published in the West Briton eleven persons expressed interest in tendering and Tender Documents were submitted to each with a return date of 12 noon on 31st January 2003. One tenderer rang to say he was not tendering and three written tenders were received by the due date. Of these one was not in accordance with the Tender Document having no evidence of Public Liability Insurance attached, one did not tender for the footpaths or playing field and one tendered full the entire works and was in accordance with the terms of the tender document. After discussion **IT WAS RESOLVED (Proposer : Cllr Millett Seconder : Cllr Ivey)** that the two defective tenders above referred to be disallowed and that submitted by Mr Paul Chegwidden be accepted so as to form a three year contract from 1st April 2003

CHAIRMANS URGENT BUSINESS

1. Cllr. Lanyon reported through the Clerk that a vehicle was dumped in Wheal Maid with numberplates in tact. Cllr. Lanyon would report to the police in the expectation that the insurers would remove otherwise he would arrange suitable removal. The Clerk was asked to write to CCC in the hope that they would help to block the entrance to the valley where cars could be driven round the ditch they had dug.
2. Cllr. Massie requested an extra meeting to discuss whether or not to finance the professional review of the CES IPPC Application. Agreed to meet on 17th February.
3. Cllr Lanyon through the Clerk had said he had been asked to post notices for the Environment Agency Public Consultation. It was felt that as the consultation was limited to sixteen people from all affected Parishes the Council would not seek to publicise the event as this could be seen as supporting the Agency's proposal.
4. Cllr Massie asked the Clerk to chase the EA to produce the copy application, which had not been supplied despite promises.
