The meeting had been called specifically to discuss the Wheal Maid valley, and current problems being experienced of noise and dust, coming from the tailings dam area and exacerbated by motor vehicles.

As owners of the tailings dams and immediate area, the Parish Council had a responsibility to address the issues. As interested parties, the County and District Councils were also present.

The Chairman opened the meeting and attempted to outline the matters of concern, but despite using a P.A. system, it became apparent that not everyone could hear or have their say. The Hall was full, there were many outside who could not gain access, and on the advice of the police, the Wheal Maid discussion was abandoned with the promise that another meeting would be held in a bigger venue, with at least two weeks notice being given via the media.
